## **New business**

1. Continuing discussion regarding possible track addition of a dirt section for Motard events. 2. Mini Enduro event – the addition of a rider change during the event was suggested. Due to difficulty in changing Supp. Regs. it was voted unanimously to keep the one rider format. In addition to the One Hour race, another multiple rider/bike race may be planned for later in the year.
3. NQ Motorshow – Horst is looking for confirmation of the clubs attendance and participants as soon as possible. Milton has forms to be completed.
4. Handicap Races – a handicapped starting system was incorporated into the last round of races at the latest Club Championship meeting. This format was agreed to be a fun way to finish a club day and should be repeated at future meetings. It was voted that club championship points will not be awarded for races that have the handicap start.
5. Qld Championships – Tim brought up the issue of case covers and oil catch trays for the upcoming Qld champs in Townsville. Riders should ensure that machines comply with the requirements as scrutineering will be strictly enforced.
6. FNQRRRC Website – Website hosting expires in May, and has been renewed for a further 12 months.
